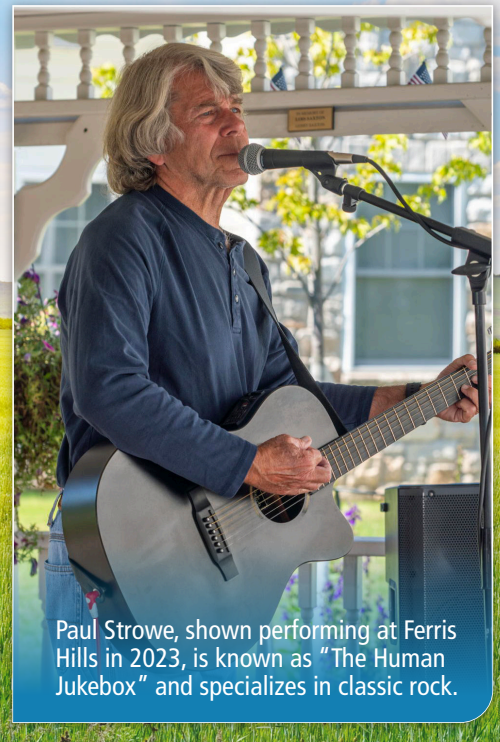
For six weeks – beginning July 17 – we'll gather in our courtyard with friends and family for outdoor concerts featuring a variety of our residents' favorite local musicians.
